- install perl
 - perlbrew or plenv
- fork your assignment
- install your assignment & dependencies
 - Dist::Zilla
- submit your pull request

docker run -it
kyzn/perlbrew-prc:x86_64

To mount a directory, put this right after 'run'

-v local-path:container-path





Calculating a score for each dist

There are two types of factor considered: (1) is it a worthy dist to assign (e.g. used by other dists)? (2) are there things that could be usefully done? For now both types of factors are mashed together to produce a single score.

Here are the factors used to currently calculate the score:

Used by other CPAN dists	1
Has issues on RT	1 - 3
Has CPAN Testers fails	1
CPANTS warnings	1-2
Has test.pl in topdir	1
Author encourages PRs	1
Module uses Any:: Moose (which is deprecated)	1
Partially deprecated	1
